How to get to Carshalton College

By train - Carshalton Station is 3 minutes' walk from the college. There are regular services from Balham, Cheam, Clapham, Dorking, Epsom, Ewell, Horsham, London Bridge, Sutton, Victoria, Blackfriars and Kings cross (Thameslink).

By bus - The college is served by the following bus routes:

- 151 - Wallington / Worcester Park
- 157 - Crystal Palace / Morden
- 127 - Purley / Tooting

By car - We are not able to guarantee parking except disabled parking, however, by late afternoon there is usually some parking available at the college and the surrounding streets are meter free
