

Future Jobs Fund (FJF) Project

The Future Jobs Fund is a government-backed initiative aimed at helping young people currently out of work to gain valuable work experience. After a successful bid; South London Business (SLB) has committed to employ approx 315 young people for 6 month periods between Jan 2010 and March 2011.

As well as work experience with SLB; we are also providing these young people with the opportunity to complete a Business Administration NVQ and offering them work placements with other organisations we associate with.

The benefits include:

No cost to you – These young people are employed and paid by SLB.

Little risk - We are responsible for managing any problems; you may end the placement or request a replacement at any time.

No hiring costs - We will recruit all candidates for you.

You can choose – we will do our best to match young people with the relevant skills to your business needs, however you will have a choice of candidates to select from if you wish.

Training & Development - We will deal with all aspects of their NVQ training and development, we just ask you to allow these young people one day per fortnight to gather evidence and meet with their assessor; to help them to gain their NVQ.

By offering a placement; you will be helping these young people to learn on the job and they will gain lots of skills and experience doing so, which we hope will help them to secure permanent employment in the future.
