It also indicates that an organisation is committed to developing its staff and maintaining quality. All qualifications contain a unit which requires the individual to demonstrate competence in health and safety practice as well as a unit which shows an understanding of the ethos of the heritage sector.</p> <p>The EDI Level 2 NVQ in Museums, Galleries and Heritage (Heritage Care and Visitor Services) gives warders, attendants, volunteers and part-time staff the opportunity to have their skills recognised. It gives a thorough grounding in heritage and dealing with visitors.</p>
