In recent years, businesses in South London have flourished, trading in growing markets. However, there is room for improvement in areas such as:

- → Transport: The movement of goods and services is vital to our economy. South London has excellent radial transport links into Central London, but our orbital links need improvement. South London Business supports the expansion of activity at Gatwick and Biggin Hill Airports; is lobbying for extensions to the Tramlink network, and an integrated road and rail network.
- → Commercial Land: Population growth is placing increased pressure on local authorities to allow brownfield sites to be redeveloped for residential use. We are lobbying the Mayor and local authorities to prevent such loss of land, and instead encourage the development of under-used sites and the construction of new commercial properties, including more mixed-use and 'incubation' space for start-up businesses.
- → Skills: A skilled workforce is critical to business success. But often the education and training available does not match the needs of employers. We are working closely with the London South Learning & Skills Council, through our Skills Alliance, to ensure the demands of business are reflected in their planning and priorities.
- → Regeneration: We firmly believe that business is a key driver in the regeneration of ailing areas. We are working in partnership with groups of businesses and their local authorities, to stimulate growth and attract new businesses into areas such as Crystal Palace and Deptford.

Businesses have to negotiate barriers to their growth on a daily basis. In many cases these are local obstacles. Each year we help secure or retain hundreds of jobs for South London companies and can help your company:

- → Business Brokerage: We specialise in acting as the bridge between you and your local authority. We will take up your business issues and work with you to tackle the external obstacles to your future growth. Obstacles such as planning disputes, local environmental issues, and staff recruitment / retention. Funded by the London Development Agency our brokerage services are provided completely without charge.
- → Commercial Property Search: If you are looking for new premises in South London and do not have the time to search through lists of properties, our free online commercial database will do it for you. Within seconds of inputting your property requirements the system searches our database of available properties, compiles a report on the premises that match your specification, and emails you the results.
- → Skills Initiatives: As your business grows the demands you make of your staff will increase and change. Working with the London South Learning & Skills Council and the London Development Agency we have established a number of initiatives to help you invest in your company by developing the skills levels of your workforce.
- → Networking Events: We can help you raise business to business awareness of your products and services; our networking events can help you make new contacts not just in your borough but right across South London.

Our role is not just to help individual companies, but also to work for the collective benefit of all businesses. In addition to our bespoke business support, we are also actively engaged with government, at all levels, to ensure that South London businesses benefit from the investment and support that they require.

- → Inward Investment: We are the recognised agency for inward investment in South London, working closely with Think London London's inward investment agency. Our aim is to attract, assist and develop new investment into South London from overseas companies.

- → Innovation: A successful economy requires a fertile environment for innovative and entrepreneurial businesses. We continue to actively promote the application of innovatio in South London businesses and successfully lobbied for the development of a South London Innovation Centre.
- → Tourism: The leisure, tourism and hospitality industry makes a significant contribution to the South London economy. Working with the London Development Agency we are activel supporting this sector through the development of a Tourism Strategy and the implementation of a range of projects and promotional services.
